• Following is the recipe for the delicious Crockpot Taco Chili Linda Kuiken served at our Friday "Heavy Hors d' Oeuvres" Night. Thank you, Linda, for sharing.

· Taco Chili - Crockpot

- 2 15 oz cans Fiesta Corn (drain liquid)
- 1 16 oz can Pinto Beans
- 1 15 oz can Black Beans
- 2-16 oz cans Chili Beans
- 1 28 oz can Rotel Diced Tomato Mild or 2 small cans (mix mild or hot)
- 1 lb Ground Pork
- 1 lb Ground Beef
- 2 packages of Taco Seasoning

Directions:

Pan fry beef and pork. Drain fat. Add Taco Seasoning and water per package instructions.

Put into <u>crock pot</u> and add the above ingredients.

<u>Low temp setting</u> – 5 to 6 hours

High temp setting - 3 to 4 hours

<u>Toppings:</u> Shredded Mexican Cheese, Chopped Onions and Sour Cream Also good with Tortilla Chips, Taco Shell, over Rice or Baked Potato or Flat Bread.
