





JEAN POTTERS AMAZING AND FAMOUS SNOWBALL CAKE

2 envelopes plain gelatin

Juice of one lemon

2 tsp cold water

1 #2 can crushed pineapple, undrained

1 cup boiling water

1 cup sugar

1 large angel food cake

2 pkgs Dream Whip (or more)

Soften gelatin in cold water. Add boiling water. Stir to cool. Add sugar, lemon juice and pineapple. Chill. Prepare 2 pkgs Dream whip. Combine with chilled mixture.

Break cake into chunks. Alternately layer pineapple mixture and cake. Before serving, top with more Dream Whip. Refrigerate until served.
